

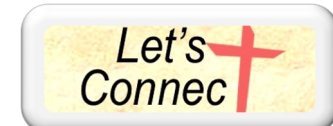

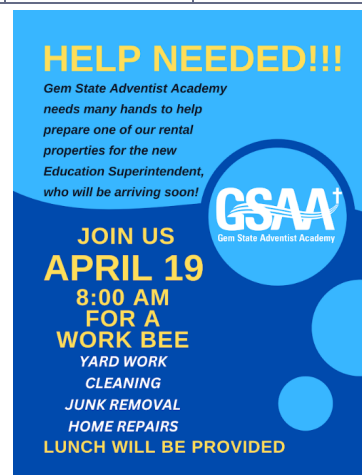
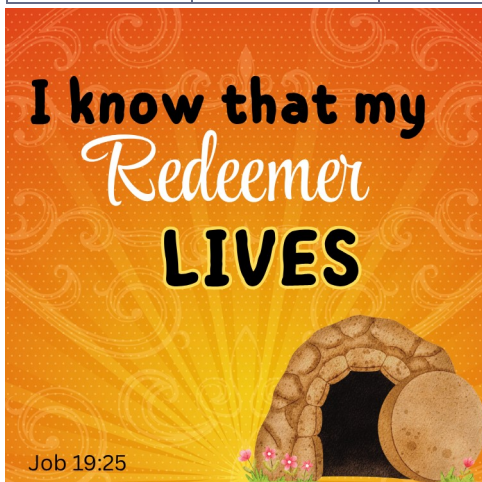
## His Tithe—Our Offerings
