


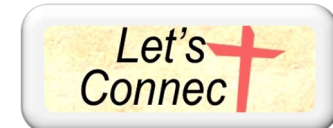

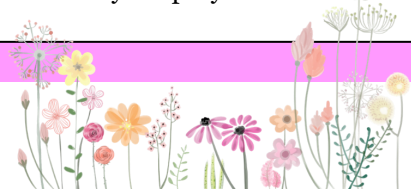
May 16 Potluck—please help us plan. Sign up in the lobby today.
