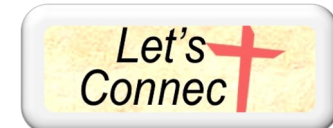

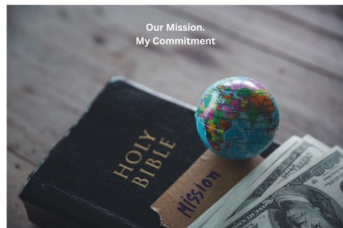

Tuesday evening is the beginning, followed by programs throughout the day each day Wed-Sab for all ages! If you have kids, they will love to participate! Be sure to check it out!

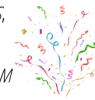
